## Equal Pay Day – April 10, 2018

Equal Pay Day is the symbolic day when women's earnings finally catch up to men's earnings from the previous year. Thanks to the gender pay gap, it takes women an extra three months of wages to make up that 23-percent difference.

Equal Pay Day was originated by the National Committee on Pay Equity (NCPE) in 1996 as a public awareness event to illustrate the gap between men's and women's wages.

Because women earn less, on average, than men, they must work longer for the same amount of pay. The wage gap is even greater for most women of color.

Wear RED on Equal Pay Day to symbolize how far women and minorities are "in the red" with their pay!

#### AAUW National Updates

- As we prepare for fiscal year 2018-2019, there are a lot of changes happening at National AAUW.
- First, effective March 16, 2018, national dues will increase from \$49 to \$59.
- Later in the month, the Strategic Planning Task Force will release its draft of an exciting and ambitious new strategic plan. (more to come on this)
- Lastly, the AAUW Board of Directors has proposed a vote on amendments to the bylaws that are now open for member comment (more on that below).

# Dues are going up at the National and local level. As a member of AAUW, you can take pride in the work you've made possible:

- AAUW Work Smart is expanding to reach millions of women from Massachusetts to California to help them negotiate for fair salaries.
- 270,000 messages went out to lawmakers last year from AAUW members and supporters calling for stronger, safer laws for women and girls.
- The gender pay gap will never be ignored again thanks to AAUW's groundbreaking report The Simple Truth about the Gender Pay Gap.
- You're standing with survivors in the critical #MeToo movement by making sure AAUW is poised to defend women of all backgrounds from sexual harassment and assault through legal advocacy and public policy progress.
- As a member, you're inspiring thousands of up-and-coming women leaders on campus.

AAUW's National Conference for College Women Student Leaders draws nearly 800 diverse college women each year.

#### Proposed Amendments to AAUW National Bylaws

The AAUW National Board of Directors voted on February 18th to put forth three proposals for bylaws amendments to all AAUW members this spring. They are:

- 1. Increase the term of directors from 2 to 3 years and stagger the election of board member terms.
- 2. Permit a limited number of directors to the board who are not members of AAUW.
- 3. Elimination of the college degree requirement for membership.

It is very important that all members exercise their right to vote and AAUW is making it simple. You will receive a PIN NUMBER in an e-mail from National along with your issue of the Outlook. You will use that pin on the web site to cast your vote, so be on the lookout for the message. On-line voting begins on April 25th and ends on June 9, 2018.

While on-line voting is very easy, those desiring a paper ballot may obtain one by calling 800-326-2289 Monday through Friday, 10 - 5 ET. Paper ballots will be available for members from Monday, April 16th through Monday, May 7th. Paper ballots must be postmarked by Monday, May 21st.

Whether you choose to vote electronically or by paper ballot, it is imperative that every member of AAUW North Hills Pittsburgh VOTES.

#### Key remaining dates for AAUW's 2018 bylaws amendment vote:

- April 16, 2018 Opening date to request paper ballot
- Mid-April 2018 Bylaws proposals and resolutions published in the spring AAUW Outlook; voter PINs emailed to members and mailed with the spring AAUW Outlook magazine to members without registered email addresses and those that have requested to receive Outlook in the mail
- April 25, 2018 Voting begins online
- May 7, 2018 Deadline for AAUW to receive request for paper ballot
- May 21, 2018 Deadline for mailing paper ballot; ballot must be postmarked by 11:59 p.m. ET to be counted
- June 9, 2018 Online voting ends at 9 p.m. ET
- June 10, 2018 Vote results announced online

#### ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

Our branch will be participating in the AAUW Membership Payment Program (MPP.) Please be on the alert for an email from AAUW National, subject-- <u>AAUW Membership Renewal Notice</u> which will instruct you how to renew your membership and pay your dues online. Again, we ask you to **please utilize this feature** as so many of you did last year. It is easy and safe. Our goal is 100% participation from those with email accounts.

**Do not attempt to renew your membership on the AAUW website!** You will renew through a <u>secured email link sent</u> <u>directly to you</u>. No login is required. You will need a credit card to make the payment of \$100.

As a thank you for doing this promptly, if you pay your dues **online** you will be entered in a drawing to receive a <u>\$59</u> <u>rebate</u> which is the amount of AAUW National dues. We have several of these rebates to offer. The drawing will take place at our annual dinner meeting on May 23<sup>rd</sup>.

If you pay by May 1<sup>st</sup> you will receive two chances; by May 15<sup>th</sup> one chance. You need not be present at the dinner to win but then you will miss all the fun!

While we encourage you to pay your dues promptly when notified by AAUW National, if you need more information or instructions we will provide that at our next Branch meeting in April. We will be happy to walk you through this process if you are unsure as to how to do this.
